SCOPE

The Virtual Institute (VI) Dynamic Pathways in Multidimensional Landscapes explores the governing principles of material functions in an internationally highly visible center of excellence. Young scientists are invited to participate in the Young Investigators Workshop 2018. It focuses on the research topics of the Helmholtz Virtual Institute 419 and includes both experimental and theoretical projects on molecular and chemical dynamics, phase transition, and switching as well as fundamental light-matter interaction.

We strongly encourage young scientists (PhD students, Master students, and Postdocs) who work in this field to apply for this 1-week workshop, and to present and discuss their results in an informal atmosphere. For eligible young researchers this Virtual Institute covers costs for the workshop fee, accommodation, and board.
